
Earth: Maps, Hemispheres, Longitude & Latitude





We use maps to represent the Earth.

World maps are representations of the Earth on a flat surface.

Political Map: shows political features like provinces, cities, towns, states.


Physical Map: Shows natural features of Earth like mountains, plains, rivers, oceans, etc.



Thematic Map: displays information about a topic or theme like population, rainfall levels, etc.

Hemispheres


- There are 4 hemispheres:
- Northern
- Southern
- Eastern
- Western






An imaginary line dividing the world into the Northern and Southern Hemispheres is called the **equator**.

It is halfway between the North and South Poles. Located **o**° **latitude**.




Hemispheres

An imaginary line dividing the world into the Eastern and Western Hemispheres is called the **Prime**Meridian.
Located o°
longitude.



Latitude & Longitude



• <u>Latitude</u> measures the distance north or south of the Equator. <u>Parallels</u> are horizontal lines which measure latitude.

Longitude measures the distance east or west of the prime meridian.
 Meridians are vertical lines which measure longitude

North, West, East, South

 Four main directions of a compass. Used for navigation and geographic orientation.
