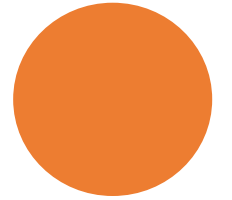
Living Things

Living things perform important processes. These include **nutrition, interaction and reproduction.**



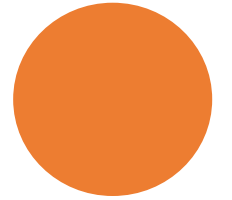
Nutrition

Gives living things the ability to transform food into nutrients.



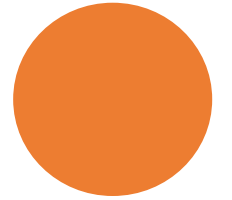
Nutrition

The ability to sense changes that happen in the environment, and to react to them.





Reproduction

The ability for living things to generate organisms that are like themselves.

Live in all areas.

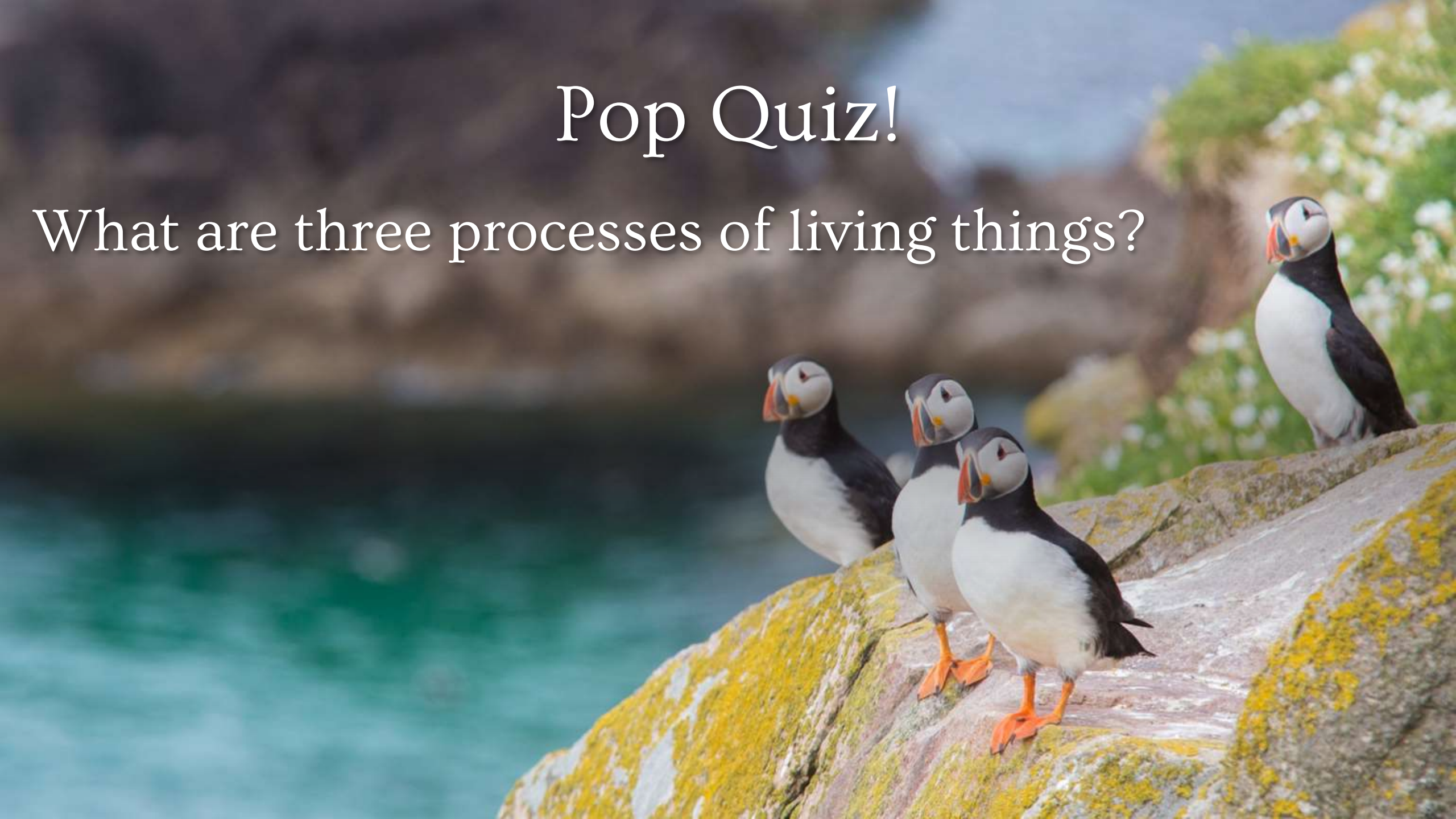


The Five Kingdoms of Living Things: Fungi

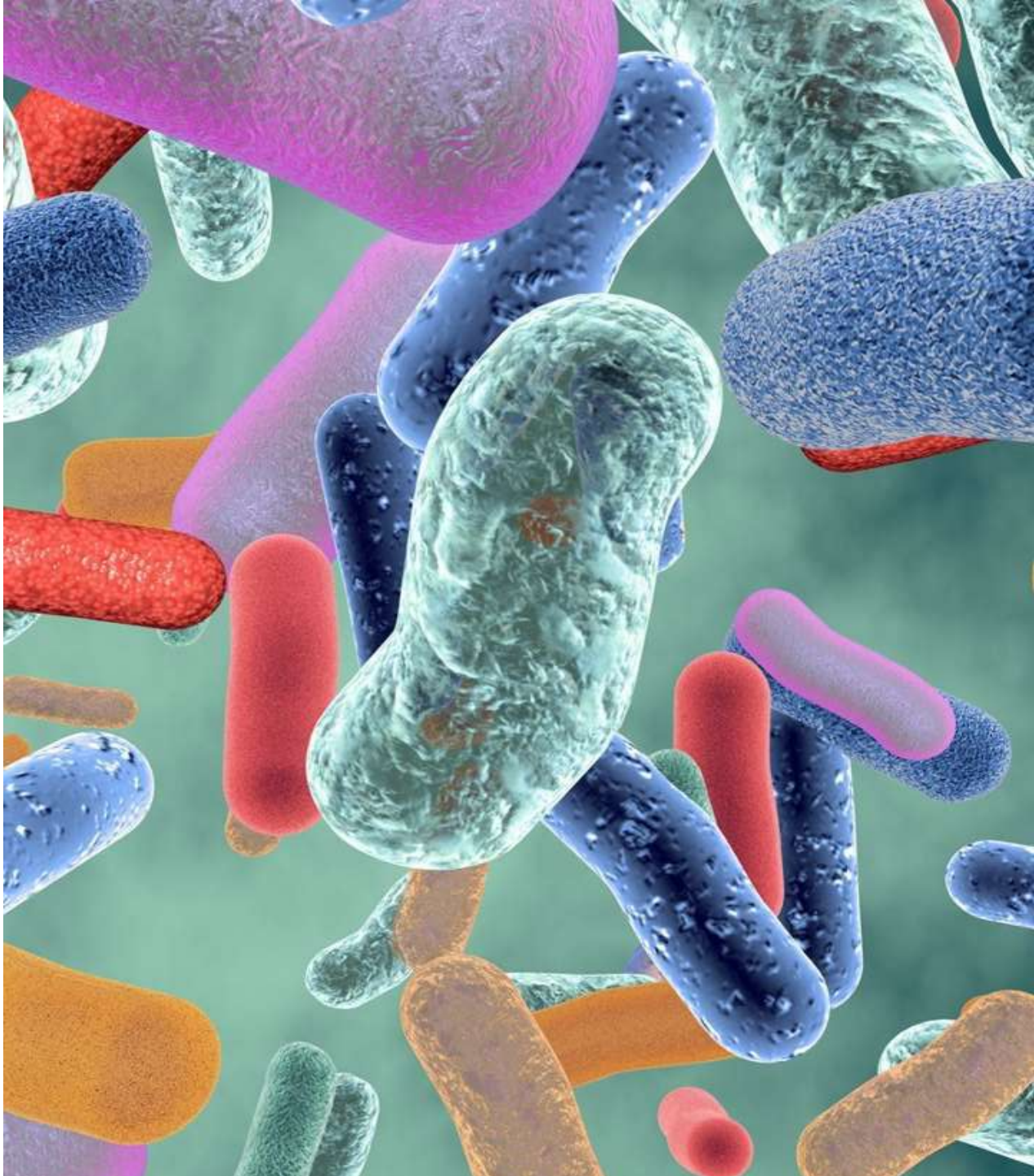

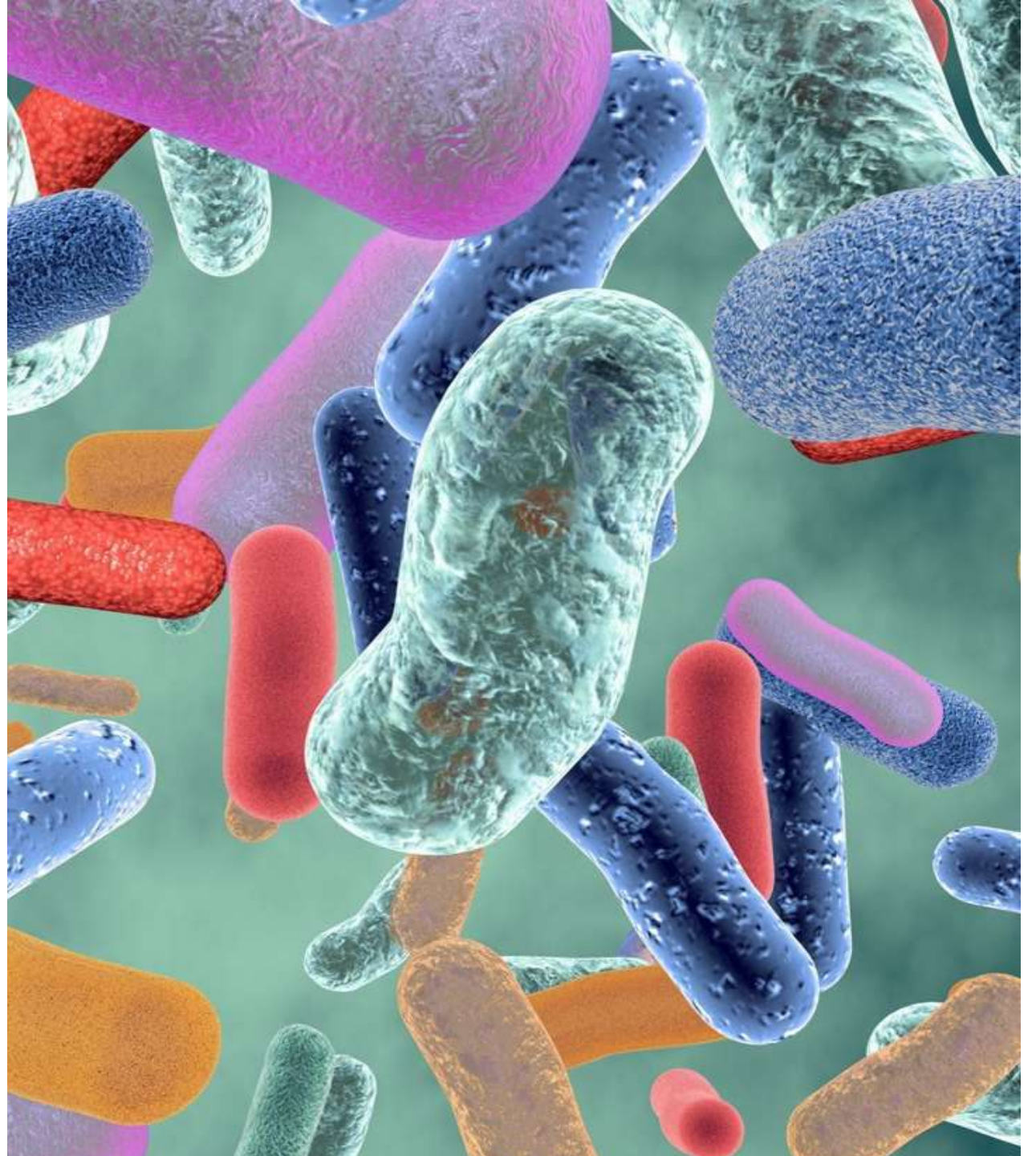
