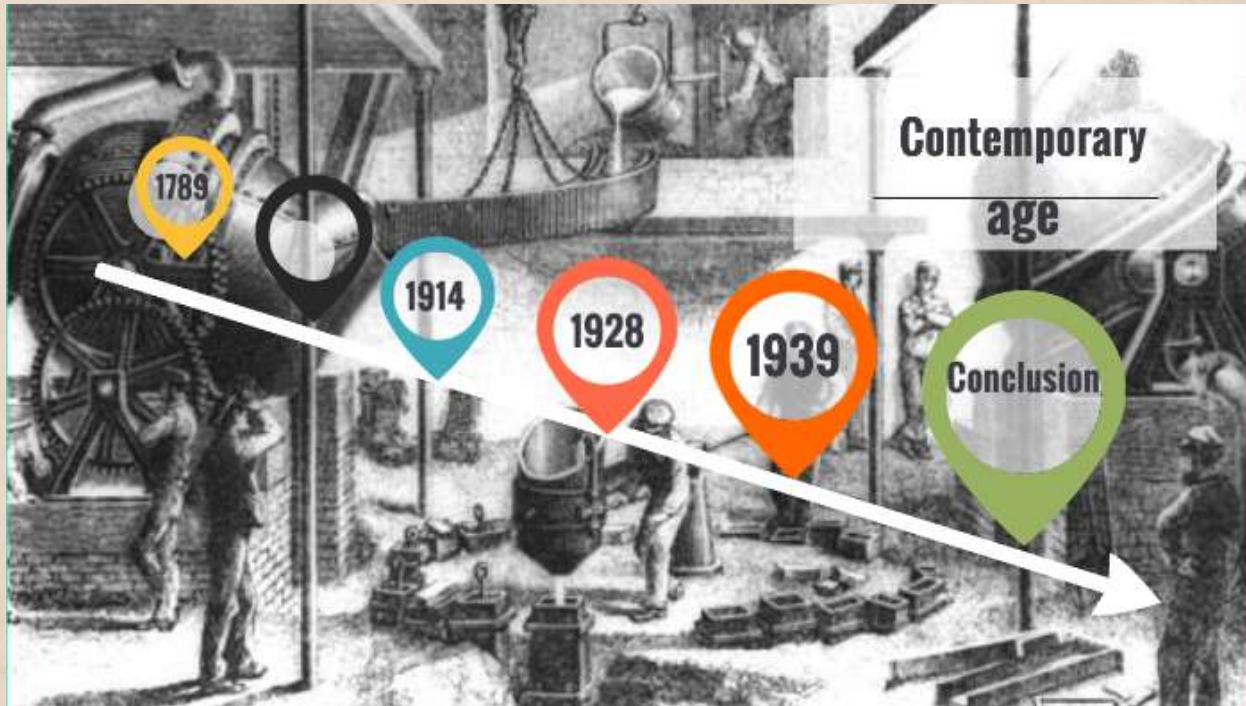


The Contemporary Age

The French Revolution

The French Revolution began in **1789** and during it the French people **overthrew** King Louis XVI (16th) who ruled in an **absolute monarchy**.

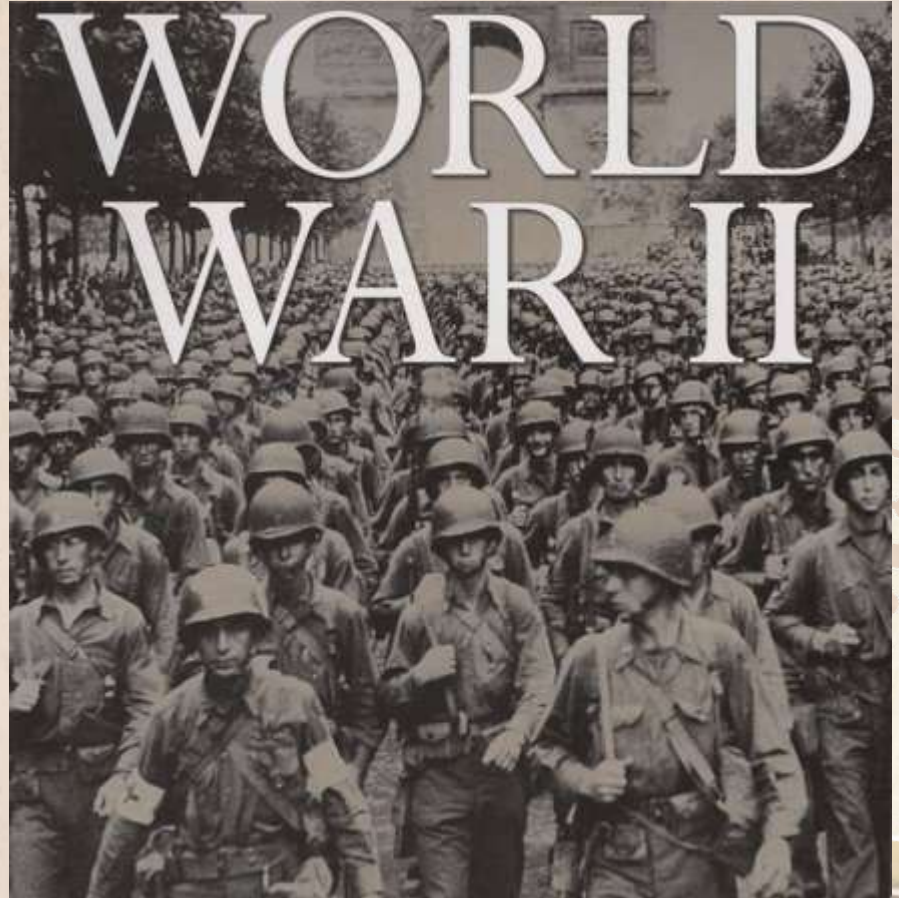

Communism

Individual people do not own land, factories, or machinery. Instead the government or the whole community owns these things. Everyone is supposed to share the wealth (\$) they create.



Communism

Examples of communist countries: China,
Cuba, North Korea



Capitalism

Citizens, not governments, own and run companies. These companies compete with other companies for business.

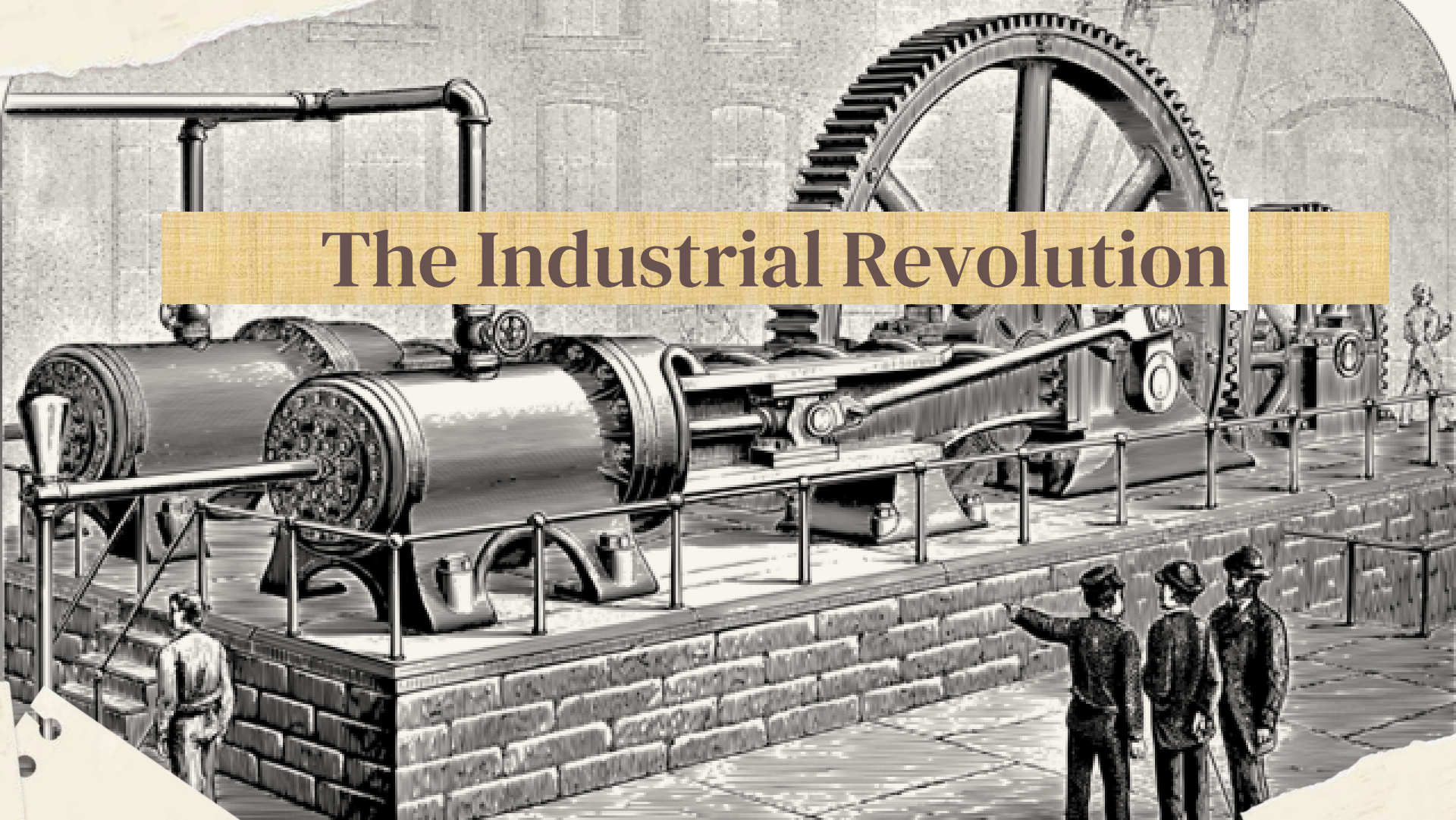

In 1769, James Watt patented his steam engine, and this invention marked the start of the Industrial Revolution in England.



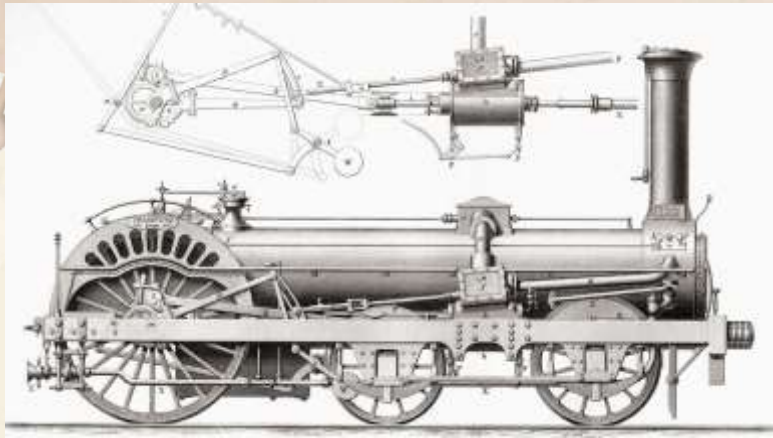

Throughout the 18th, 19th and early 20th centuries, the Industrial Revolution reached the rest of the countries.



The devices that worked with the steam engine, such as the locomotive, the loom or some agricultural machines, allowed workers to change from producing in an artisanal way to work in the factories of the cities and producing on a larger scale.

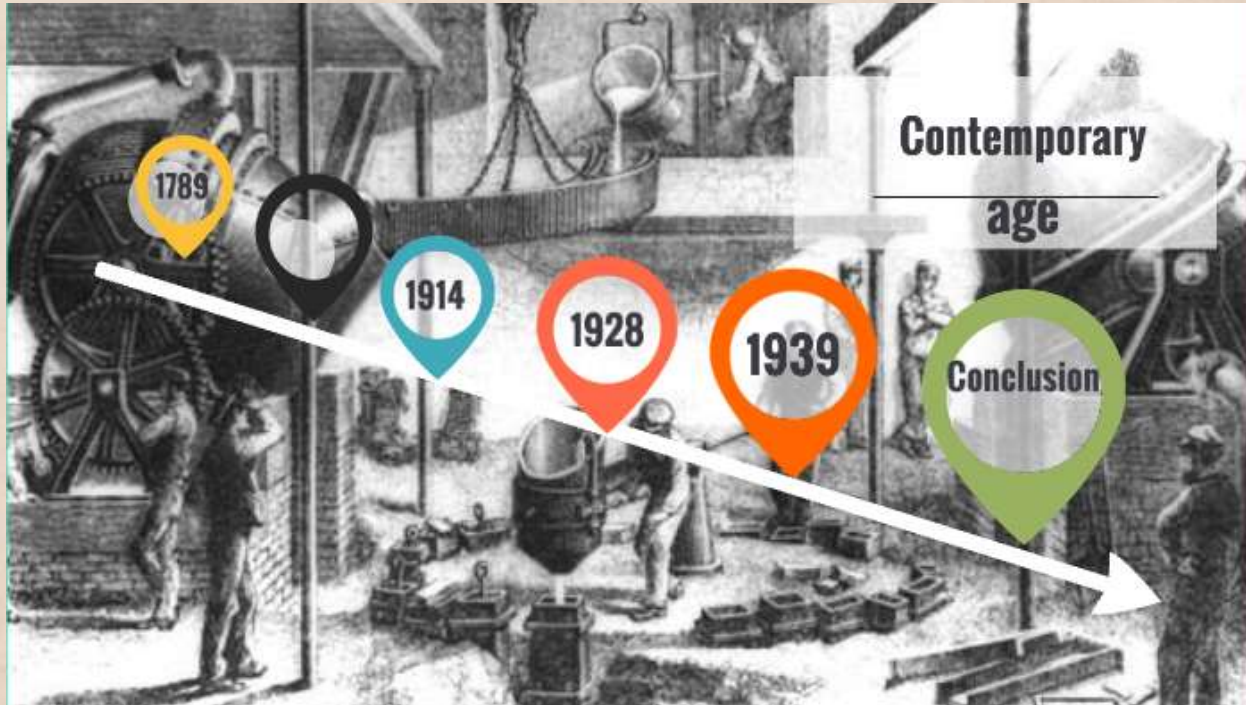
