<p><b>Accommodation</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Where to live in town?</li> <li>- Possibility of staying with a family?</li> <li>- Possibility of sharing a flat with teachers?</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- It's easier to live in the north of the city to be closer to school, but you can live anywhere in the city and the school won't be too difficult to get to.</li> <li>- I would recommend the neighborhoods: Alameda, San Julian, Macarena, and San Vicente.</li> <li>- You can find housing on the apps Idealista and Badi. I think it's better to use facebook apartment search groups, though (less chance of an agency fee). The group "Habitaciones en Alquiler en Sevilla" is good and the link is here: <a href="https://www.facebook.com/groups/879359335432444">https://www.facebook.com/groups/879359335432444</a></li> <li>- Get housing early! It becomes difficult to find a cheap place after all the other auxiliares and students arrive in September. If possible, arrive earlier in the summer to secure a nicer, cheaper place. Do NOT send money to a landlord without first viewing the place in-person — many people get scammed this way. Make sure you have a contract.</li> </ul>
